The seminar will take place from Monday to Thursday, 3 hours per day-

Since the Summer School will be open to all disciplines, please be aware that your seminar should be designed for a heterogeneous student group.

#### **Payment & Travel Costs:**

We can offer a small honorarium for 12 teaching units (45 mins per unit + (oral)exam/paper/project supervision etc.) Grading will not be necessary, since students can only pass/fail the Summer School.

Travel and accommodation costs can be covered by Erasmus+ Teaching Staff Mobility of your home university.

All lecturers will receive a teaching certificate and free admission to the cultural excursions.
