ERUA brings together five young European universities that have joined forces to form a transnational university network with common values and goals in research, teaching and institutional development: The Universities of Paris 8 (France), Roskilde (Denmark), Konstanz (Germany), of the Aegean (Greece) and the New Bulgarian University (Sofia, Bulgaria) have all been created as places for educational reform in terms of curricula, interdisciplinary approaches, open science, assessment process and student engagement.

This alliance is based on a common ambition to develop a new type of collaboration, which connects European universities and makes it possible to rethink their place in the global context.

All members of the teaching staff can apply (enseignants-chercheurs, ATER, chargés de cours, doctorants).

#### • When?

The Teaching Weeks should take place between **November 2<sup>nd</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> 2021.** If these dates do not convene to your schedule, please do not hesitate to contact us.













## • Where?

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the common lecture or seminar should take place as a virtual exchange.

Physical mobility can be financed through Erasmus+ staff mobility for teaching, if the organization of the planned teaching activities meets the Erasmus + requirements.
